- 1. IP Policy and Minute Taker
  - a. Policy accepted with Mike taking the minutes
- 2. Demo
  - a. Demonstrated changing of contact and location on printer in the room and embedded device emulator through ACS in Amazon Cloud server
  - b. Q: How does the device get the data from the ACS?
    - A: The device "pulls" from the ACS; device sends request to ACS which responds
  - c. Q: Does the device have an open listen connection?
    - A: Yes, but the device can also poll (and the ACS can tell the device when to poll)
- 3. Translation Issues
  - a. Length limits for parameter names requires removal of redundant name components
  - b. Mapping choices and unions (not supported by CWMP data model)
  - c. Gathering counters from multiple print services on one printer; need roll-up counters, which are part of the Service object which isn't currently translated...
    - Should probably machine-translate System Object and strip out the rest of the properties for now (just what is needed for printing)
