- 3. Print Job Ticket and Associated Capabilities

  - b. All level 2/3 headings in sections 1-3 and 13 appear to have been changed to regular paragraphs?!?
  - c. Line 271: "In multi-document jobs" (missing hyphen)
  - d. "datatype" vs. "data type" use "datatype" since that was used in the MFD Overall spec
  - e. Figures 3, 8, 13: enlarge to fill page?
  - f. Line 462: PrintDocumentDescription is supposed to be a heading, where is the text?
  - g. Top-level headings: start on new page
  - h. Q: How does a client get capabilities?
    - A: Using an operation (Get-Printer-Attributes in IPP)
      - Client can cache capabilities and localizations of printer-specific values
        - Standard attributes and values can use a common set of localization files on the client
        - IPP WG (Mike) will supply standard US English strings file for all currently registered attributes and values, informative reference in JPS3
  - i. Q: What about the size of the localization files
    - Entire IPP registry (XML) is about 760k, strings file will be (much) smaller
  - j. Q: What about authentication information (OAuth2, etc.)?
    - Not part of job ticket, passed as part of the transport (e.g. IPP/HTTP authentication) for the operations
      - Only thing in the job ticket is the "most authenticated" name and/or URI
  - k. Section 8: CONDITIONALLY REQUIRED is repeated, bad reference to section 10
  - I. Section 9: Duplicate conformance requirements with section 8
    - Make section 8 "Conformance Requirements"
    - Sub-sections for PrintJobTicket, PrintDocumentTicket, and PrinterDescription
    - Drop current section 9
      - Clarify client/server conformance requirements put it in the beginning of each sub-section
        - Printers must support all required and applicable conditionally required elements
          - Clients have no conformance requirements aside from using the schema

- Q: Do you have to supply a job ticket?
  - A: No, defaults apply
  - Make text starting on line 480 more visible/move to front
  - Q: What about natural language in the job ticket?
    - A: IPP and WS pass natural language as a required element in the operation
    - Add an implementation note (Ira to draft) for how natural language is carried along with the job/job ticket/document ticket
    - Also note that all strings can have arbitrary languages other than the natural language value in the job ticket
- m. Section 13: Remove template text
- n. Q: What about JPS3 references
  - A: We can do the PWG Last Call and then hold the vote to happen concurrently with JPS3
- o. Q: Is this document sufficient?
  - A: For a standalone implementation, yes. For an alternate implementation we want the mapping document as well.
  - Get this document in PWG last call ASAP, then get mapping document finished up.

  - Xerox provided notice of prototyping
  - WG Last Call to mid January 2012 for both SM and Cloud groups
  - PWG Last Call to span February 2012 F2F
  - PWG Formal vote concurrent with JPS3 in April 2012?

  - Contact Justin if your company has questions about the license
- c. Action: Justin to work with Microsoft Legal on the appropriate citation/reference to MSPS based on the new license for inclusion with the MSPS content in the mapping document, and any process for the PWG to make a formal request
- d. Q: Is Microsoft Legal comfortable with MSPS info being part of a completely open document?
- e. Q: How do PWG members review the MSPS content?
  - Need members to get approval to use the click-through content
  - Affects concalls or f2f as well as last calls and formal vote
  - Make sure we don't show MSPS documents in PWG meetings, just the mapping tables
  - Q: Can Justin and Ira start work on document before MSPS has been published?
  - Yes, Samsung can work on it
- g. Q: Can we include any MSPS content in the spec?
  - A: Not until the new document is published and the necessary legal guidance from Microsoft is received
- h. Action: Ron or Bill to post a call for wider participation of driver developers for the XPS/MSPS stuff
- i. Line 158: Missing word "as": "never occur AS top level elements ..."
- j. Table 1:
  - Map PWG Copies to JDF DocumentCopies (JDF SetCopies maps to PWG JobCopies)
  - Remove elements that only exist as part of a complex type, remove note 1 (no longer needed) and use of italics
    - Delete DocCopies/DocumentCopies map?
  - Confirm mapping of copies
- k. Section 3.12 NumberUp add PresentationDirectionNumberUp and maybe do a table with the numbers/values that correspond
- I. Section 3.13 Password need to map to DocumentPassword (from JPS3)
  - Also fix Table 1
  - Ira: Re-check for any JobPassword corollary in JDF
- m. At the beginning of section 3, talk about JDF using 0-based ranges while PWG/IPP use 1-based ranges.
  - Action: Mike to make "first-index" in JPS3 1-based instead of 0-based
- n. Section 3: Fix use of "while the PWG-PJT ..."
- o. Re-add requirements/rationale section back to document
- p. Re-add conformance section to describe the recommended minimum implementations of mappings
- 5. JTAPI stuff from Job Ticket spec
  - a. Is there interest in doing a whitepaper?
  - b. Or just post a PDF to the whitepaper directory so we retain it for posterity
  - c. Action: Bill to post the PDF of the JTAPI content as a whitepaper
