General Discussion

- Ira went over the proposed specification (see http://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/ipp/wd/wd-ippstate10-20061011.pdf). The comments follow:
 - Remove "subunit-turned-on" and "subunit-turned-off" below powerup and power-down in Section 5.1.3
 - Fix the numbering of the enum values x 1,000 (to avoid collision with other objects and allow for expansion)
 - Add "staple almost empty". Also consider other "almost empty" values.
- Group was reminded that the target is operational status not management.

- Craig pointed out that the process with IPP-SPX (responding to a real requirement from BMLinkS, followed by making small changes to the existing specification allowing for additional capabilities, working toward a reference implementation) worked well.
- Ira indicated that Paul Danbold (Apple) has talked with Michael Sweet about putting IPP-PSX in CUPS.
- Best practice: specification should provide a rationale for work "not done" for future reference.

Next Steps / Open Actions:

- The specification will be revised next week (incorporating the changes above) by Ira.
