 - Smith: talked internally about special media source to select this behavior, but that could get unwieldy in media-col-ready/database
 - Bill: Virtual paper tray could be an option, but would be limited to specific sizes
 - Mike: Already supported by clients
 - Ira: Virtual trays should be labeled as such in the MIB/ printer-input-tray
 - Bill: What to do about errors, e.g., cutters that might be used, etc.
 - Mike: imposition-template is a more logical mapping, but doesn't capture merging of multiple jobs in order to optimize roll usage, not supported by clients
 - Use Case: User wants to print small pages on a roll, with the output being laid out to minimize media usage.
 - Possible changes to NODRIVER spec:
 - Additional values for media-source member attributes:

- naming scheme, etc. so that Client knows the tray is virtual
- Values for printer-input-tray, trickle-back to Printer MIB prtInputTable
- Values for printer-output-tray, trickle-back to Printer MIB prtOutputTable
