



It is expected that initially this mechanism will be used with Initiators that have Logged into the Target at least once in the past. This simplifies and limits discovery to Initiators and Targets that have a history of successful communication.

This specification does not limit the use of the Login Request to discovery via history. It is valid for a Target to perform a Login Request to an Initiator that it has not previously communicated with.

**Do we need to mention discovery for this or is it out of scope?**

When a Target that does not have a current Login requires communication with an Initiator, the Target may write the Message\_Request data to the Initiators Message\_Request register with ctrl\_function Login\_Request. The Initiator shall respond with Message\_Response data written to the Targets Message\_Response register with ctrl\_function Login\_Request and a response value which indicates the status of the request. If the response indicates request completed OK then the Initiator will Login to the Target.
