2 General

3 Project Update - Proxy Provider

- > Rick indicated that the project code has been updated and is complete.
- ➤ He has posted a new test run output and analysis files ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/cim/proto-testlogs-allfiles-20090406.zip
- The code package should be released (with the license information) in the next three weeks
- Rick will accept MIB dumps for additional testing, particularly of marginal circumstances, for the next month
- ➤ Ira asked whether Rick would be able to extend the provider code to address the Finisher MIB, since there was some both finisher supplies and marker supplies allowed the listing of certain items, this causing some potential ambiguity in mapping certain elements to CIM
 - Rick answered that he will try to address the Finisher MIB at some time in the future
 - He would need assistance with samples and explanation of the potential problem areas.

4 CIM Print Services

- Ira had no new information on the CIM Services effort
- Ira and Rick again discussed issues relating to handling of capabilities and settings in the CIM context

5 Power Management

- > Bill briefly went though the analysis of the Power Management survey results
- ➤ He then went into discussion of an outline for a Project Plan.
- ➤ However, in subsequent email communication and a review of the PWG Process document (ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/general/pwg-process-30.pdf) it became apparent that a workgroup must be chartered to start an Imaging System Power Management project. The PWG Steering committee has been informed of the survey results and it will be up to the PWG Chair to determine if and how that is to happen. Certainly, such a group will require a Chair, Vice chair, Secretary and, once spec drafting commences, an Editor.

- ➤ Rick will release the Proxy CIM Provider code some time in the next month
