  - c. Follow up with "Additional langPDF/PS/PCL variants" submission to IANA after 14 May end of comment period and all comments have been resolved Ira
  - d. Rick Landau and Ira McDonald: review Print Service related MOFs, generate CRs, and submit to CIM (open)
- Next Conference Call is at 2:00 PM EDT on 24 May.
- Subjects for the June face-to-face were considered. It is expected that there will bean update on Power Management efforts and possibly some processing of MPSA input, perhaps with MPSA member participation.
- Future WIMS Activity was discussed. The Power Management documents await prototyping. The PWG membership has shown little interest in the new WIMS activities that have been suggested, including update and advancement of the Port Monitor MIB, CIM Printer Profile Activity, MFP Alerts etc. Therefore, except for possible projects coming out for MPSA liaison, it might be appropriate for WIMS to suspend activity after the June Face-to-face meeting.
